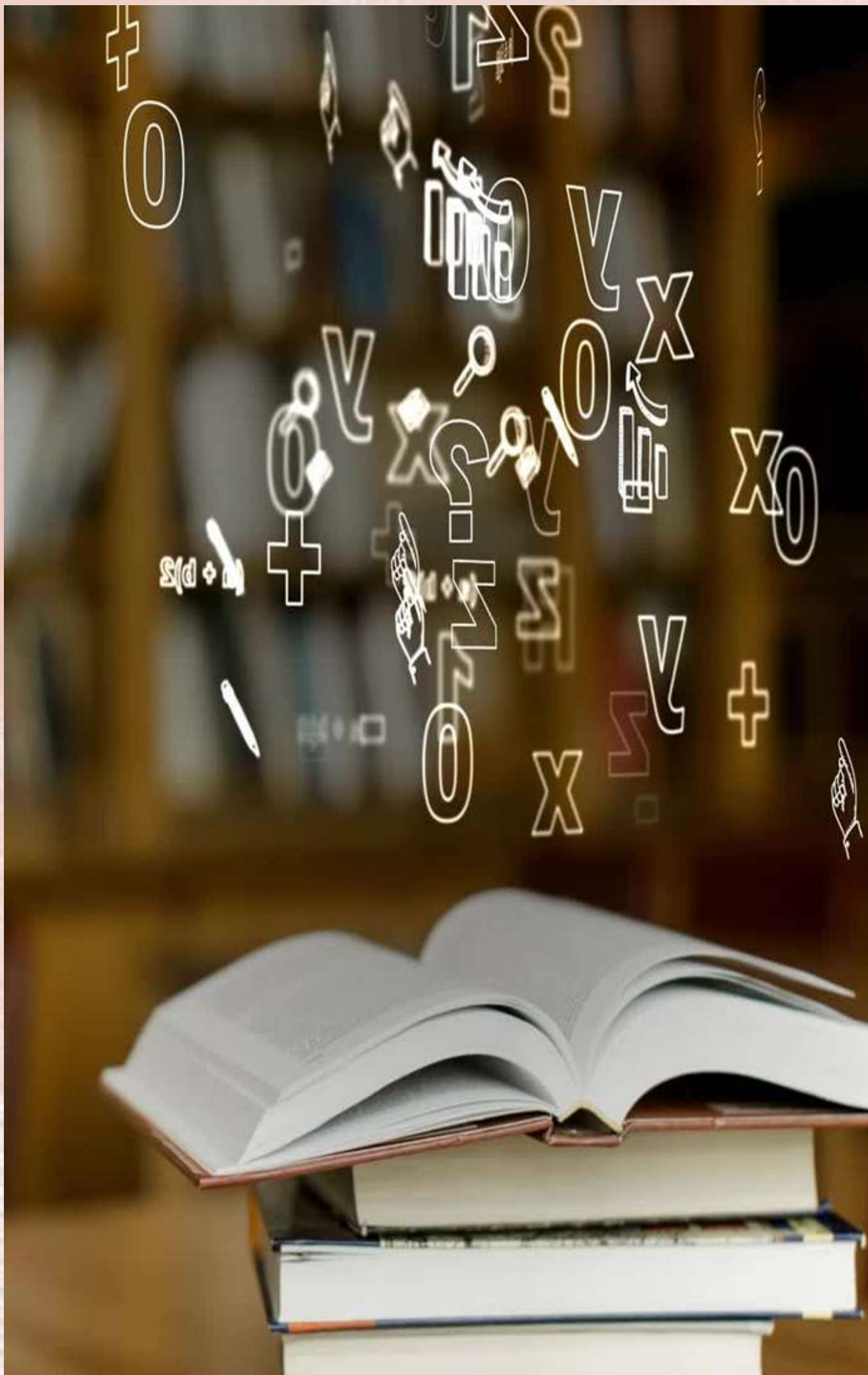

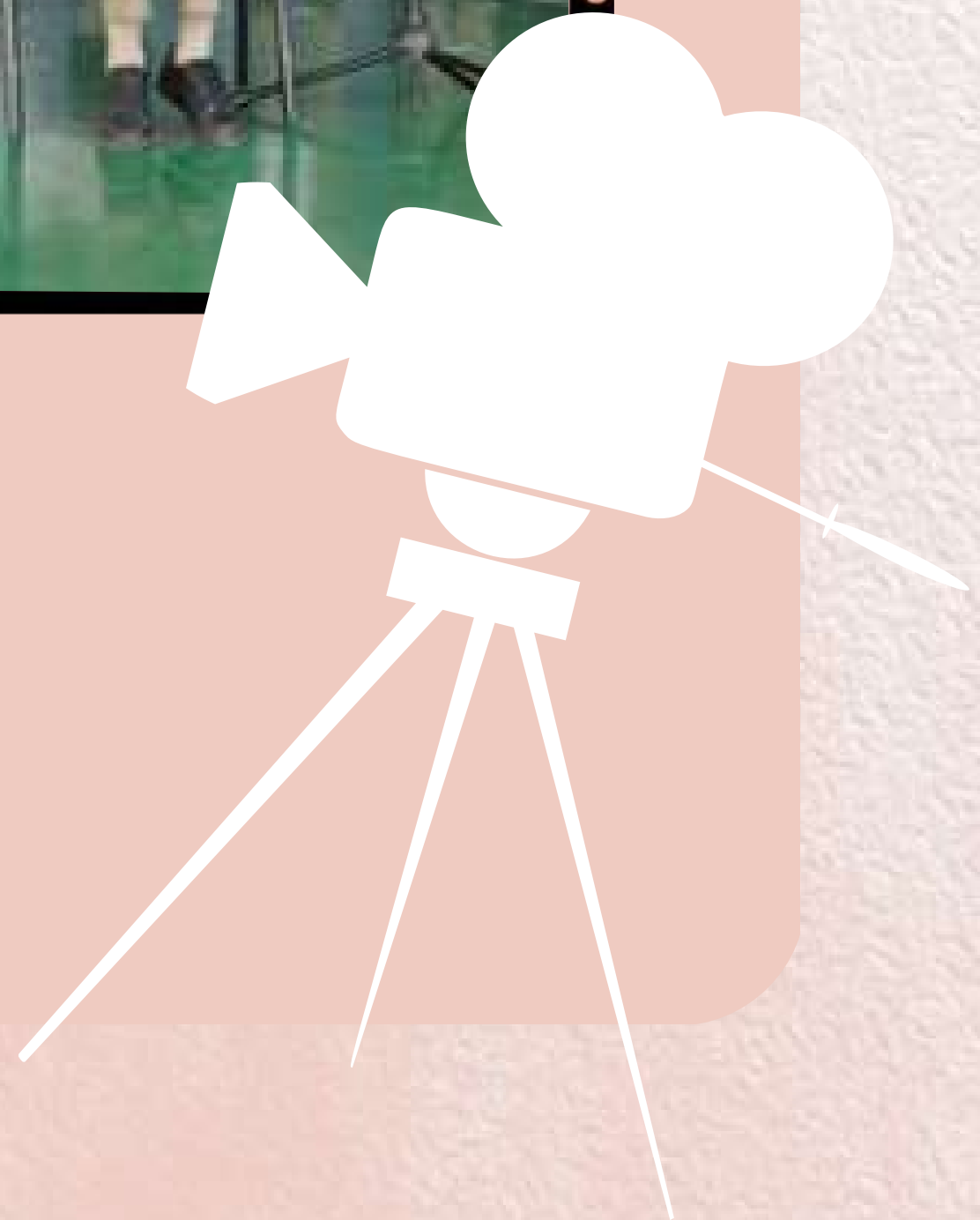

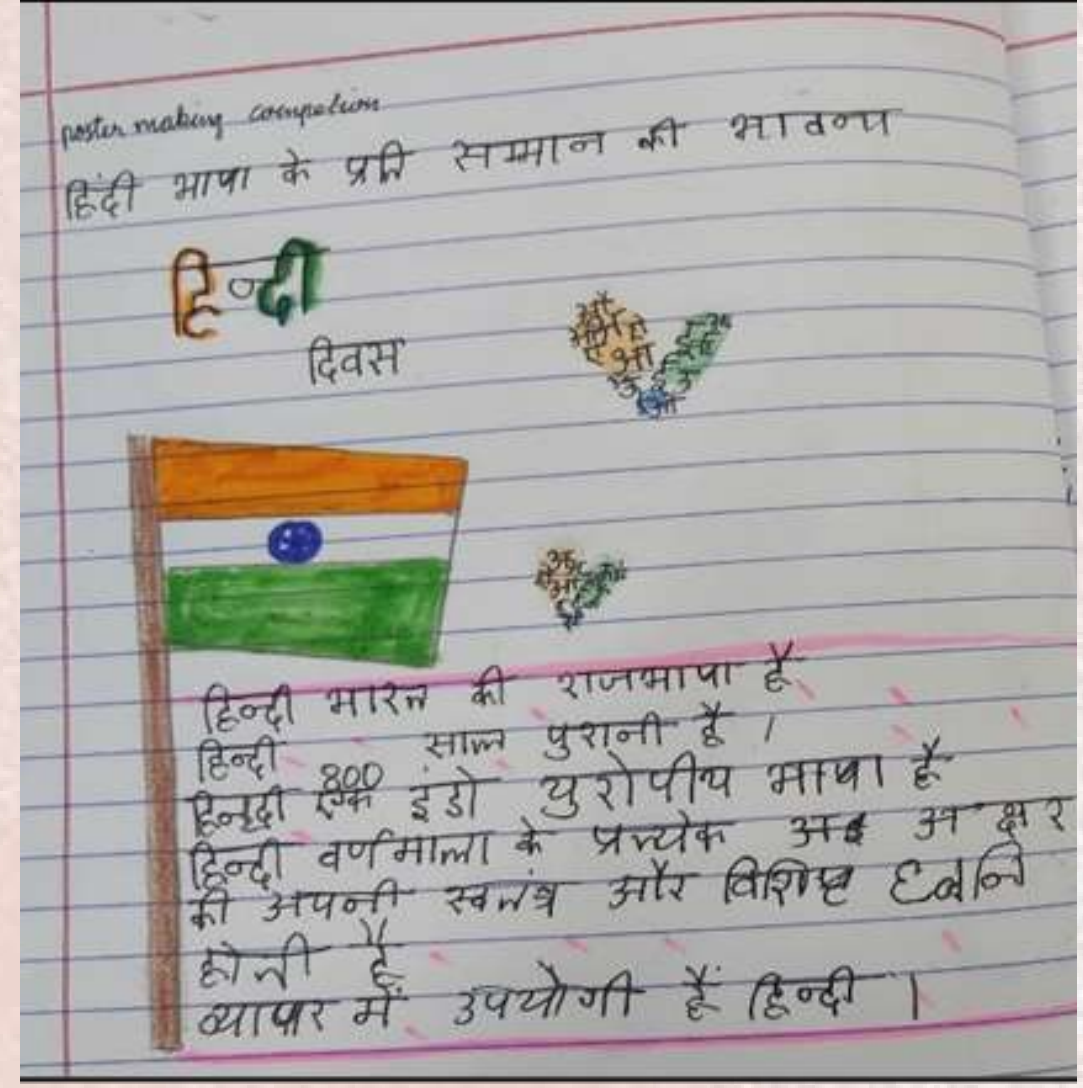
Teacher's Day

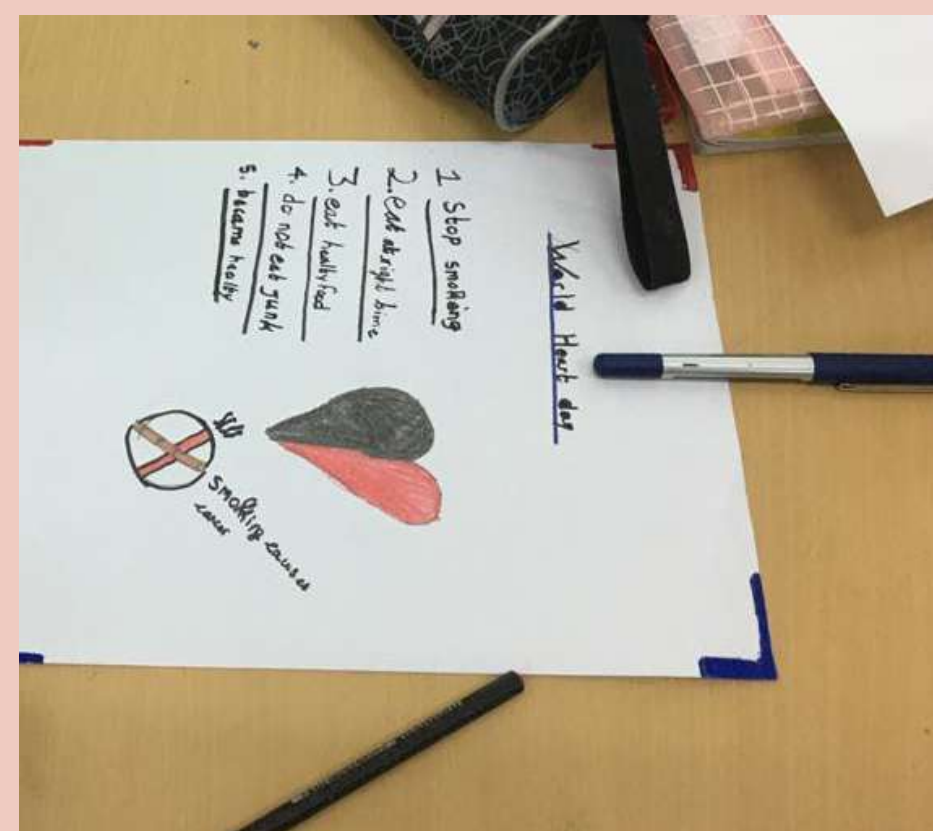
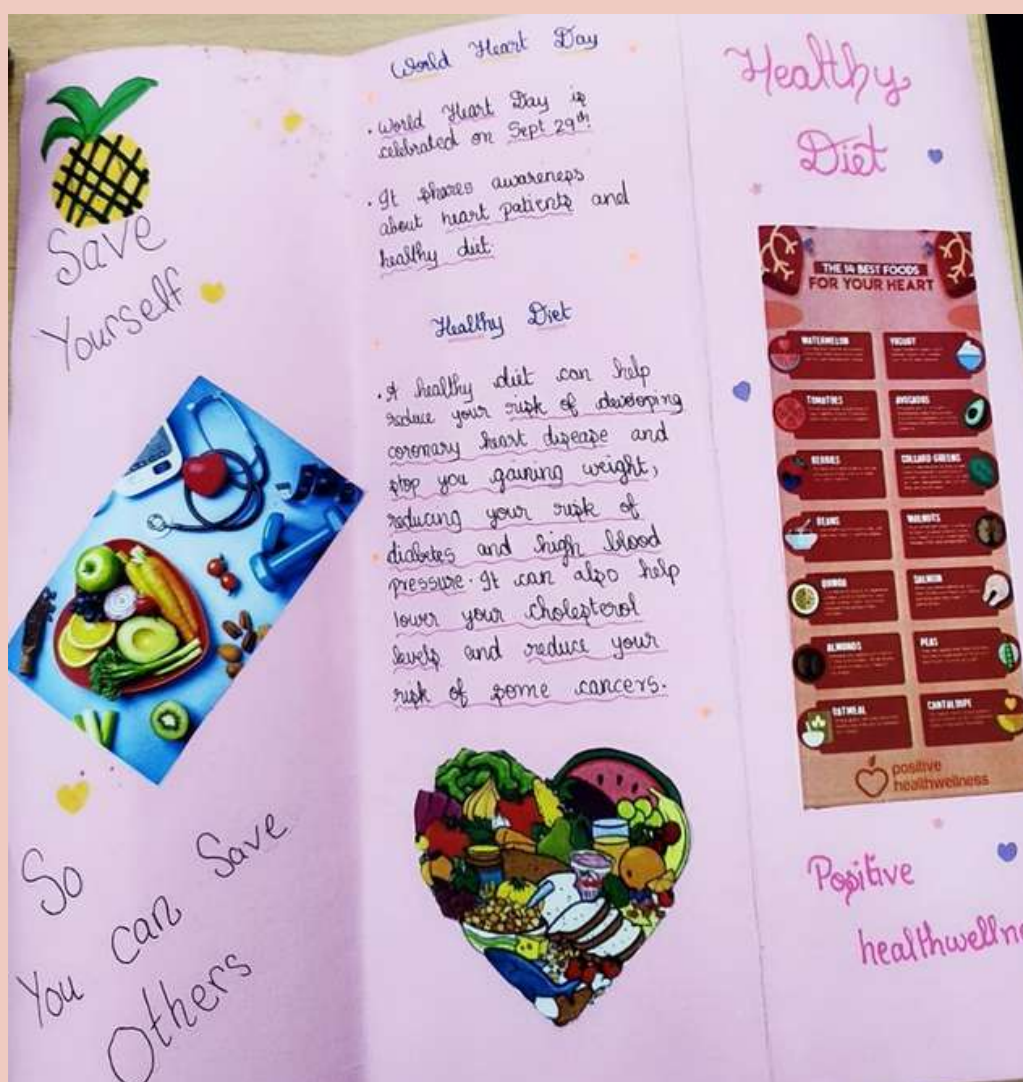


World Heart Day

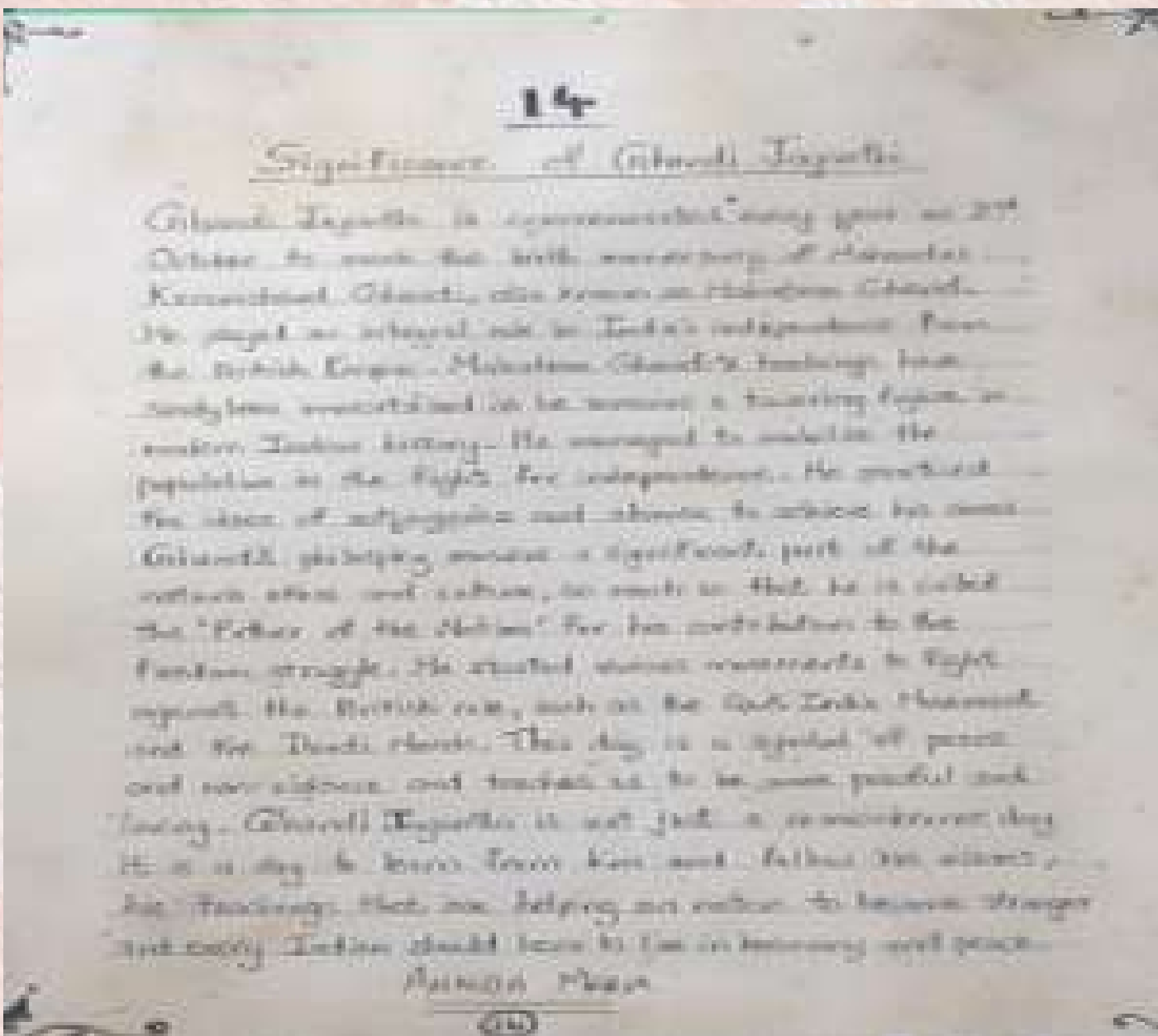
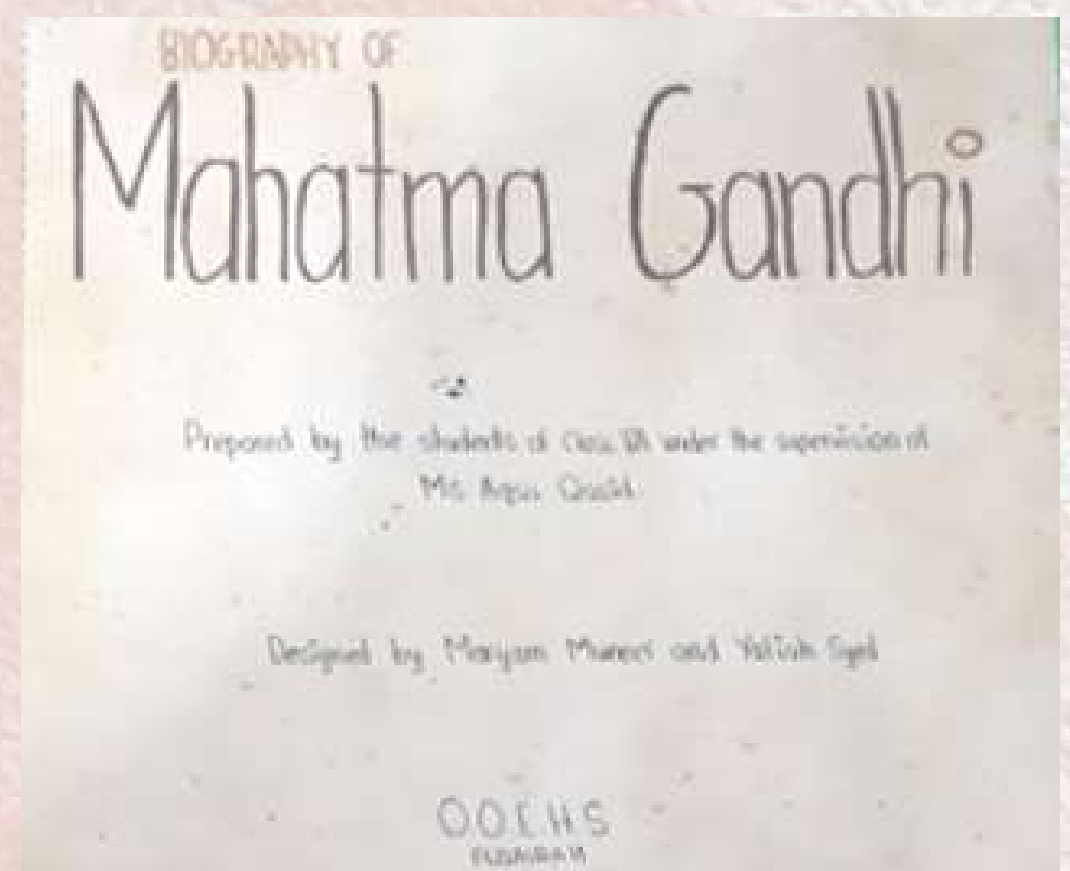
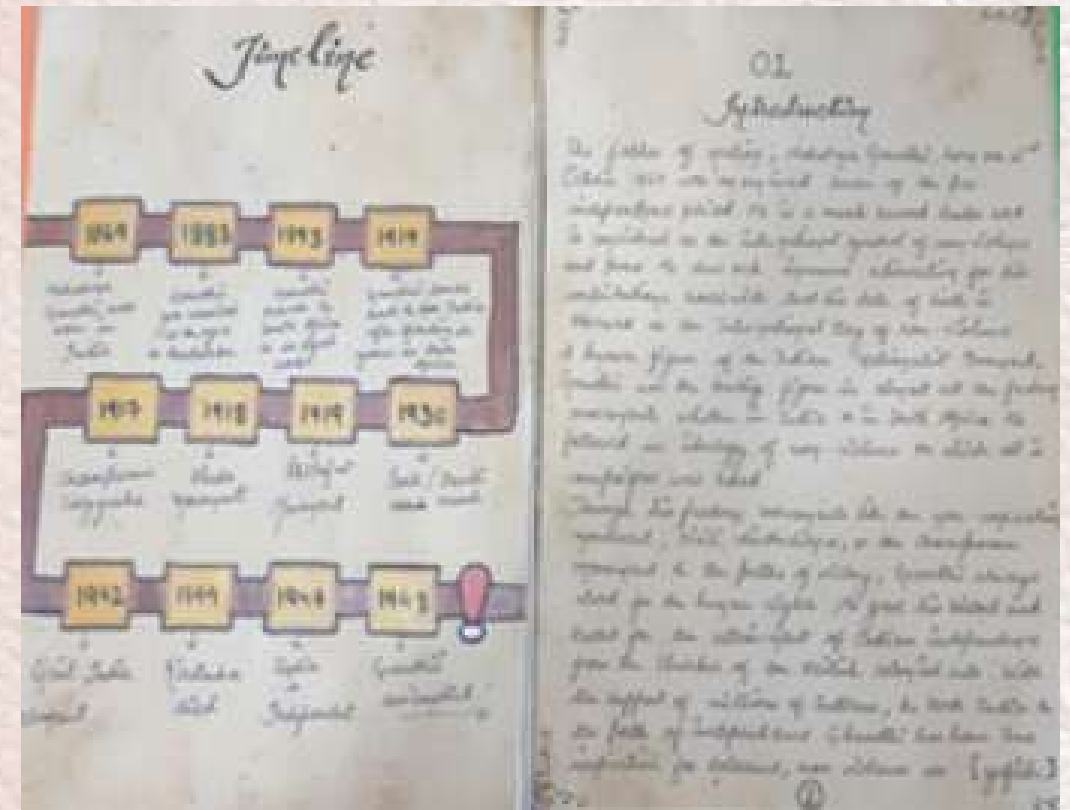

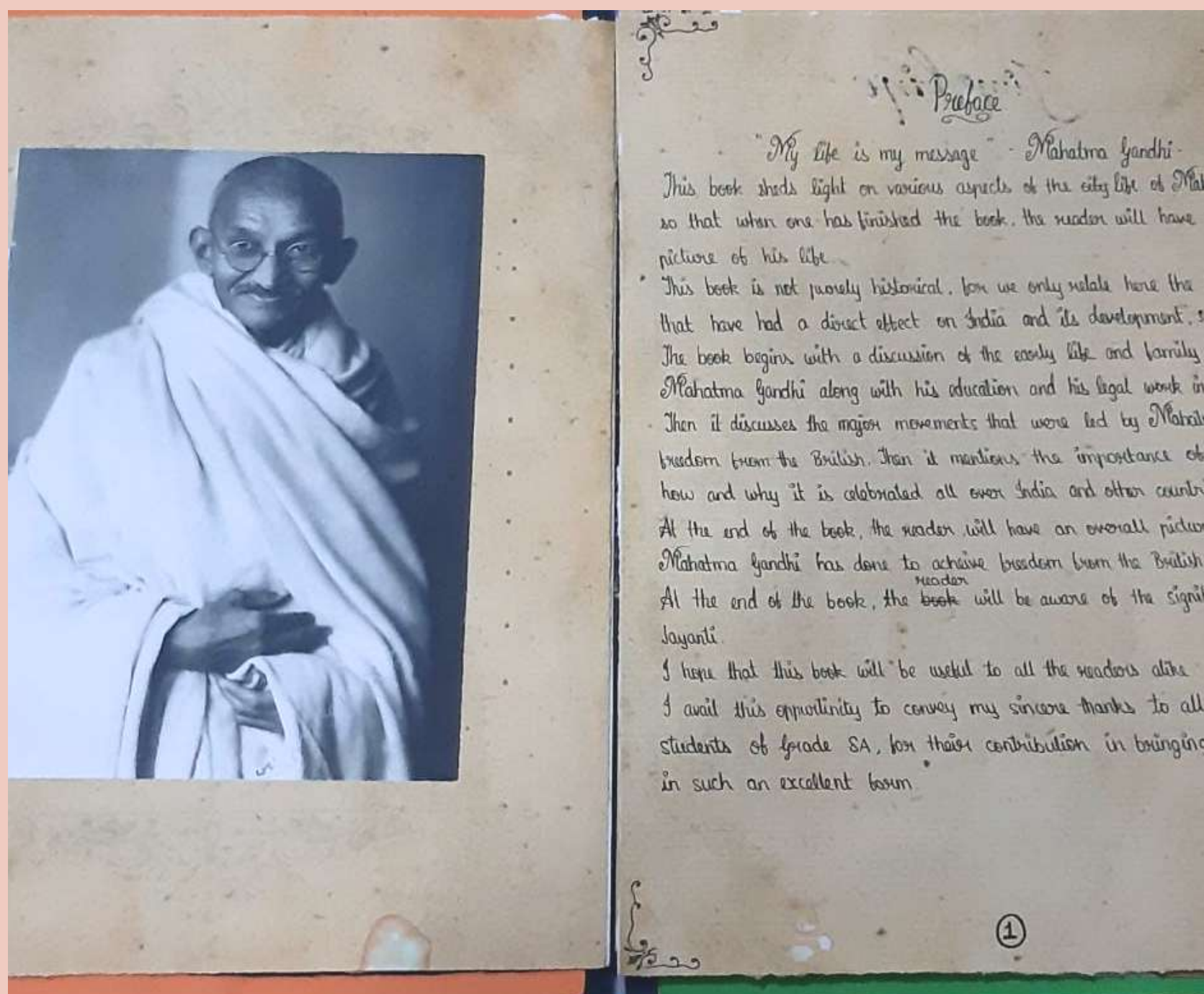
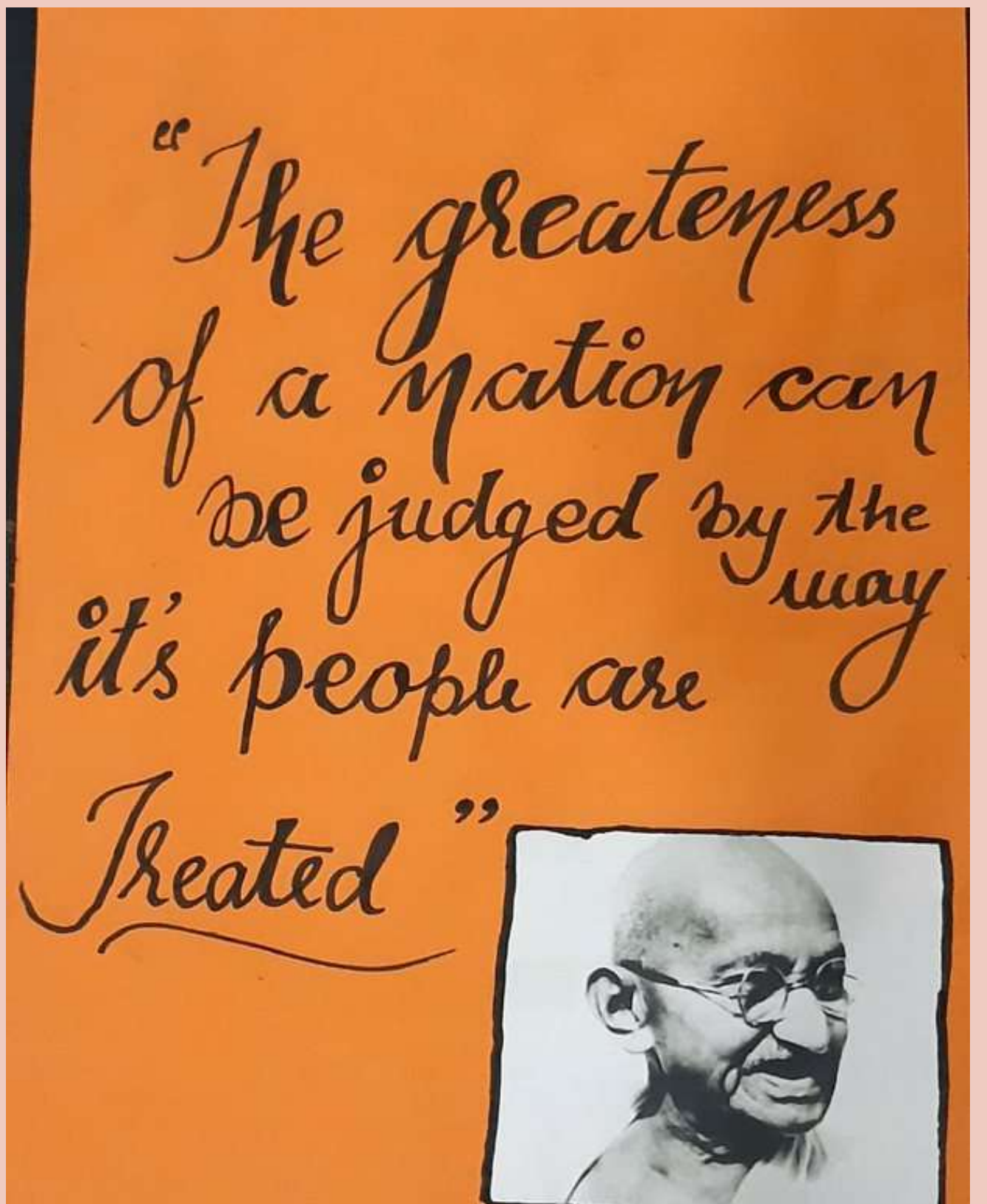
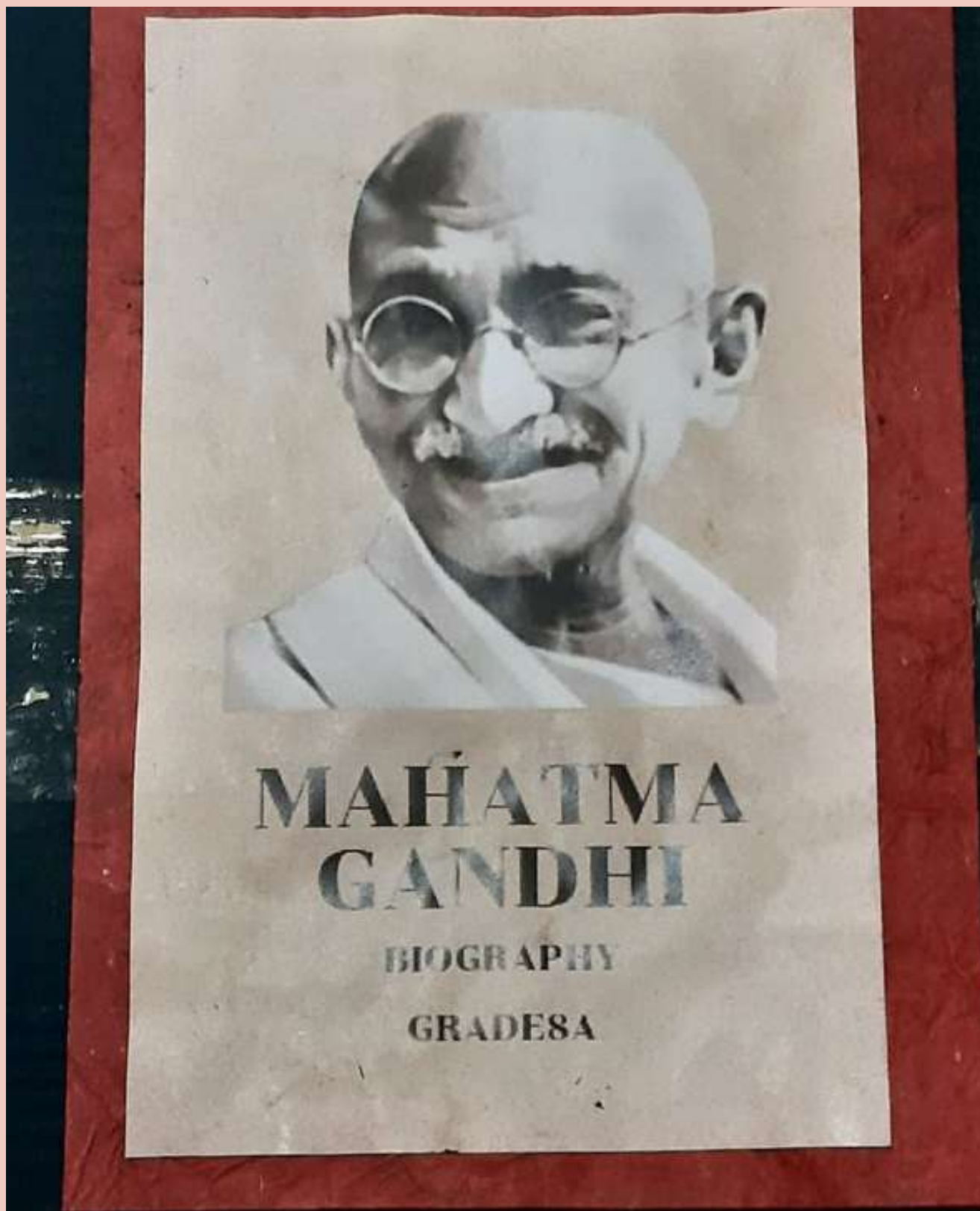


Gandhi Jayanti

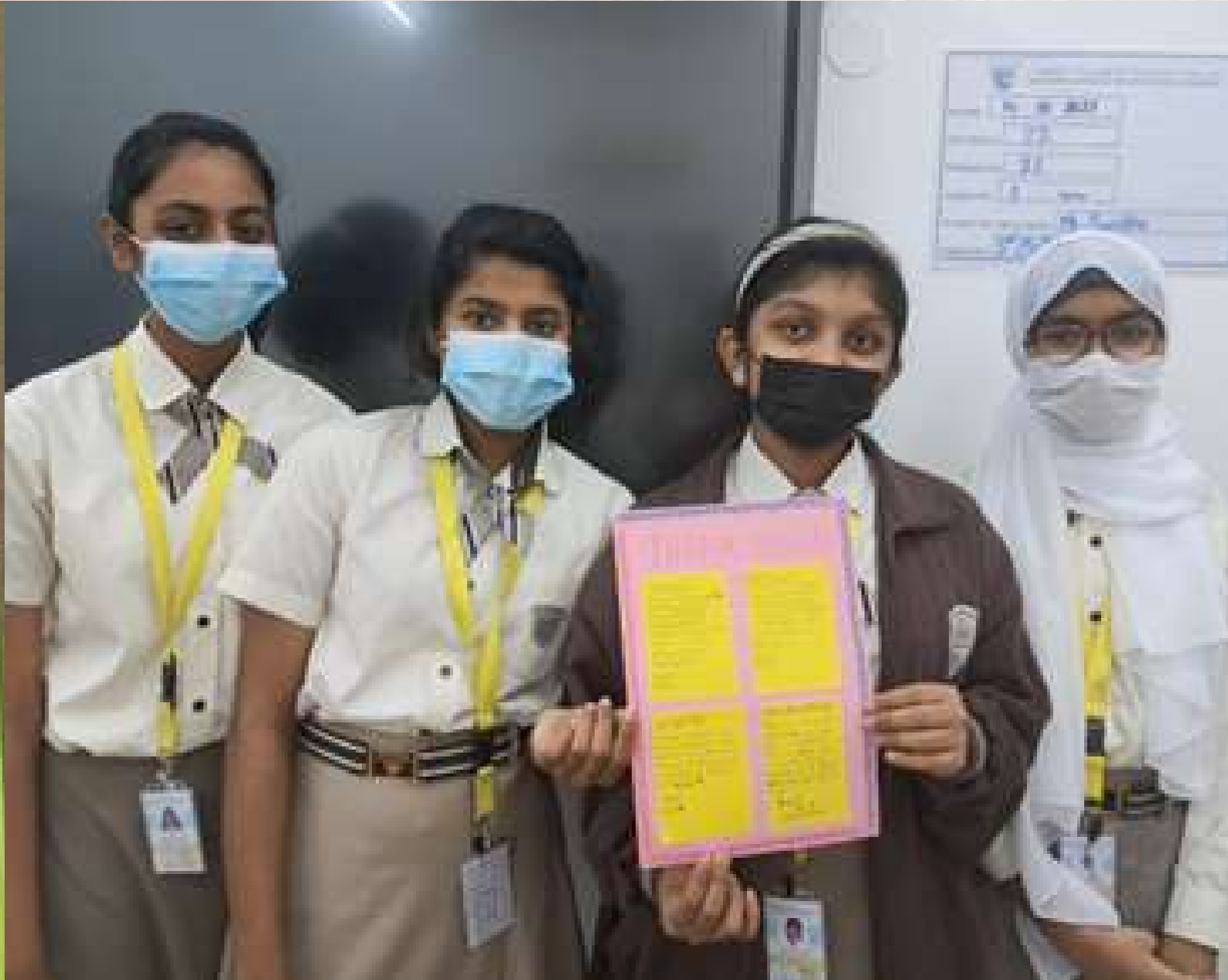

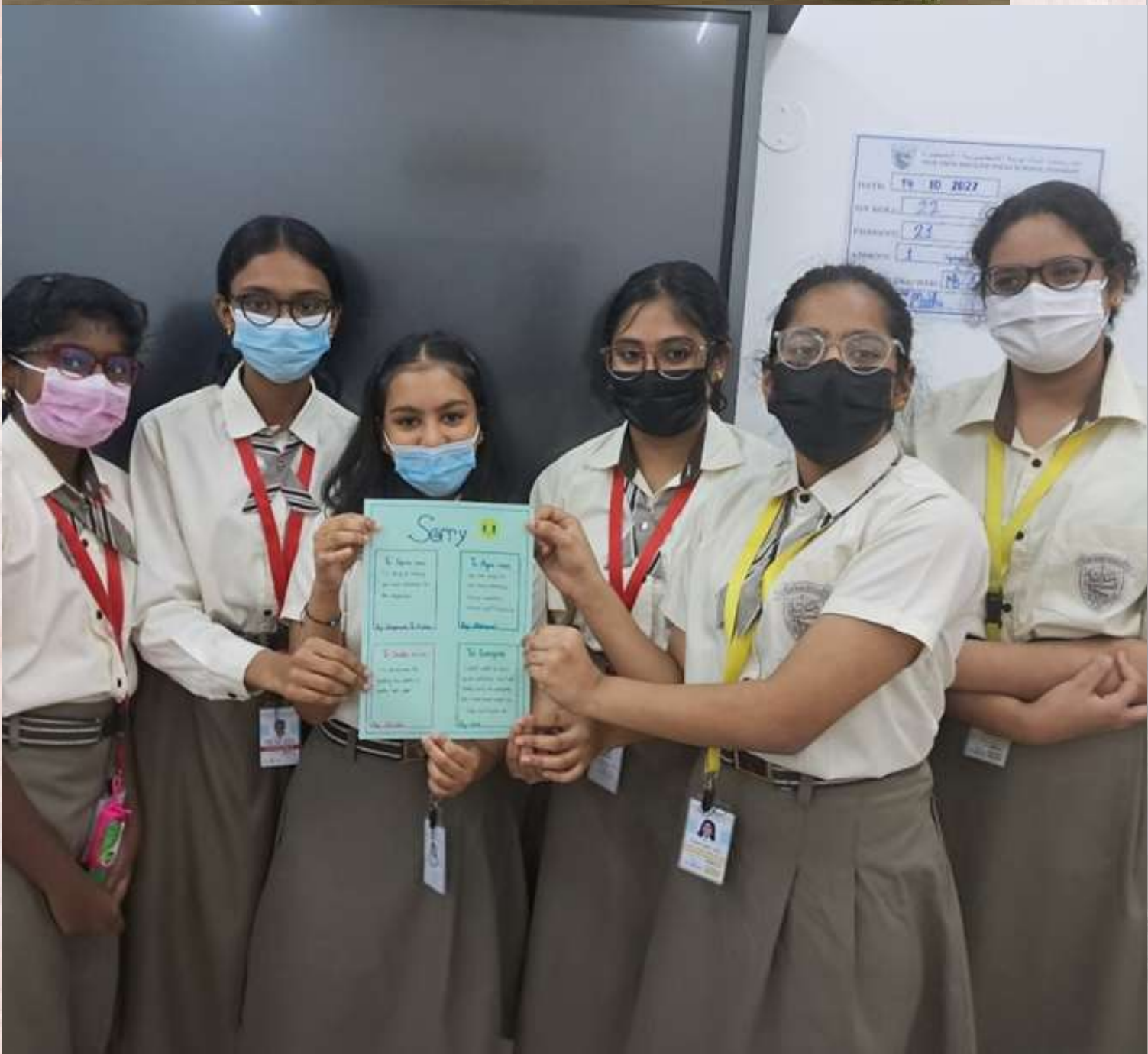

Dear Mom and Dad,

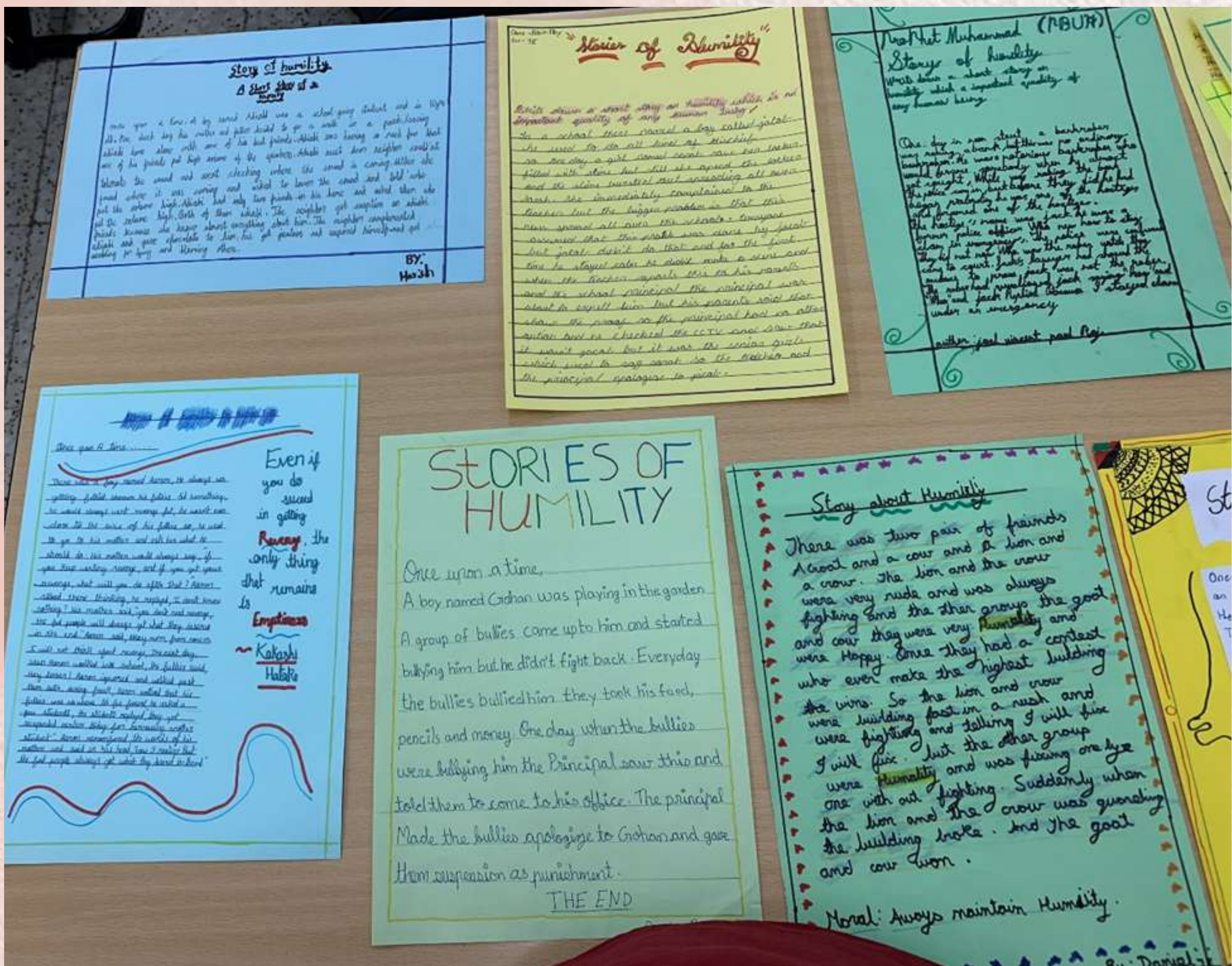
First thing I love you, though I am not able to show you in my actions, I am sorry I won't be able to you guys so a lot of hardwork face problems, but you and there just my life could be better.

World Science Day

Middle School Science Department observed World Science Day on the 10th of November with great enthusiasm and remarkable fervour. Age-appropriate activities were planned and assigned to various classes.

Grade 3: Test for Starch

Students brought bread and potato to class and tested the presence of carbohydrate. This experiment was conducted using iodine solution.

Grade 4: Vinegar-Baking Soda Experiment.

Students inflated a balloon with the help of the reaction of vinegar with baking soda. The children observed the release of carbon dioxide.

Grade 5: Paper Chromatography

Students observed that ink used for writing was a mixture of dyes through the paper chromatography experiment.

Grade 6: Anerobic Respiration

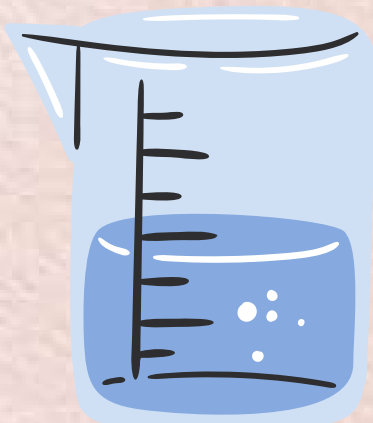
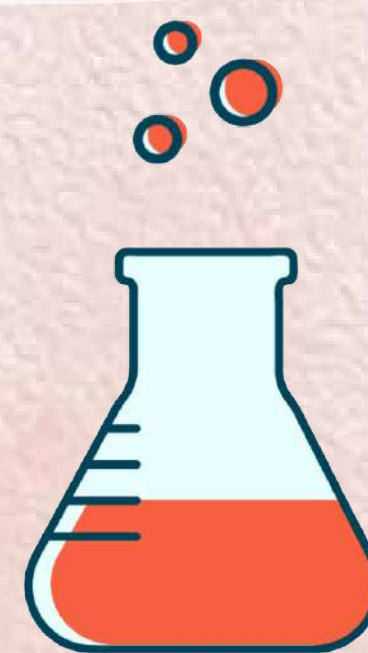
Students proved, through an experiment, that carbon dioxide was released during anerobic respiration. The experiment was conducted with the help of a sugar solution and yeast.

Grade 7: pH Value Detection

Students concluded that different solutions have different pH values. The students experimented with a selection of liquids using pH value paper.

Grade 8: Adverse Effect of Sugar on Teeth

Students observed the changes affecting teeth after drinking sugary liquids. They used eggs, Coca Cola, vinegar, and water to conduct the test.

The day commemorates the birth of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the country's first Prime Minister who believed that the future of the country rested in the hands of children. The CBSE Middle School teachers conducted a special assembly for the students. 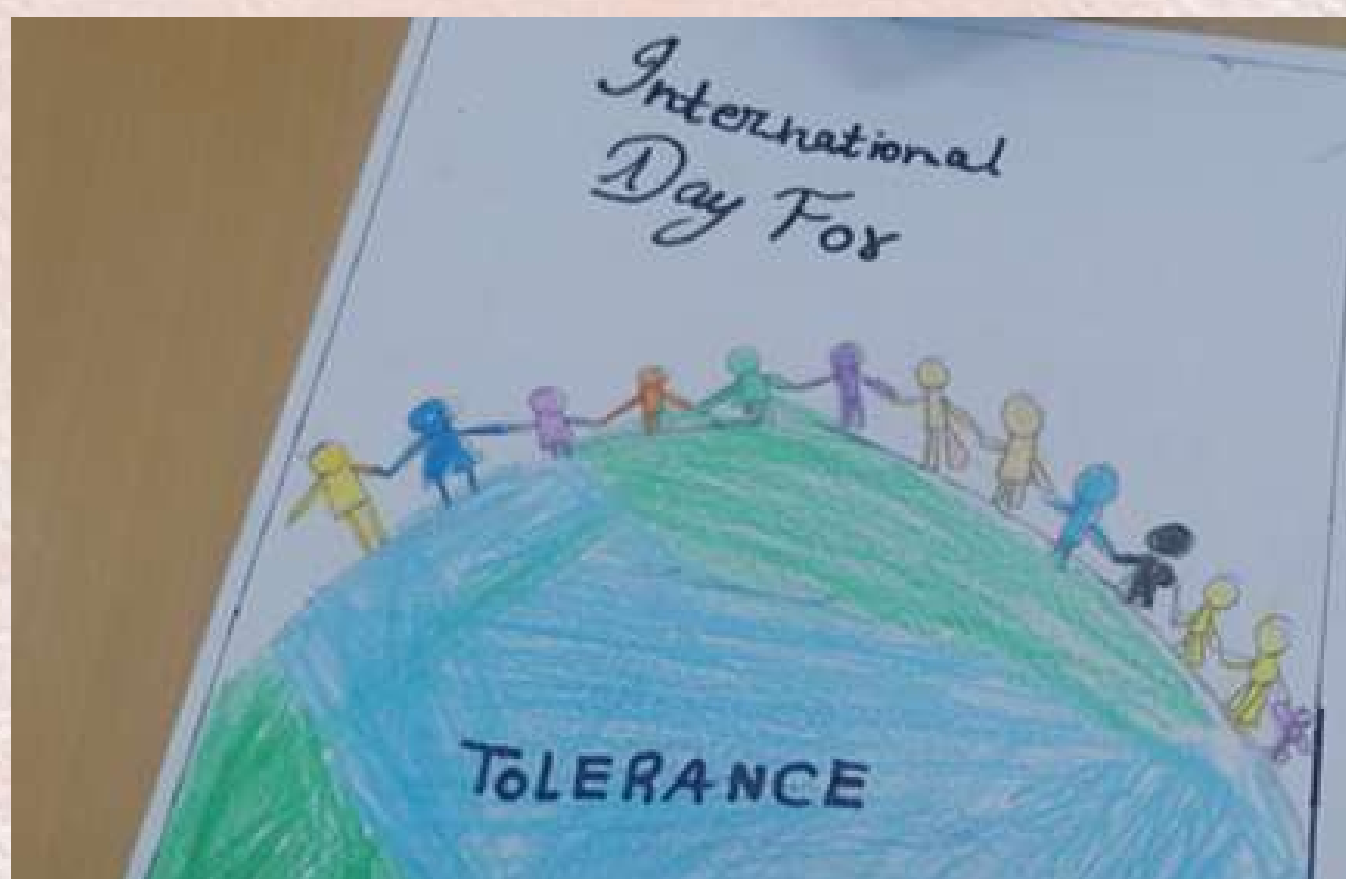




International Day of Tolerance
