OOEHS students and teachers celebrated World free car day. Students were shared the benefits of using cars less.

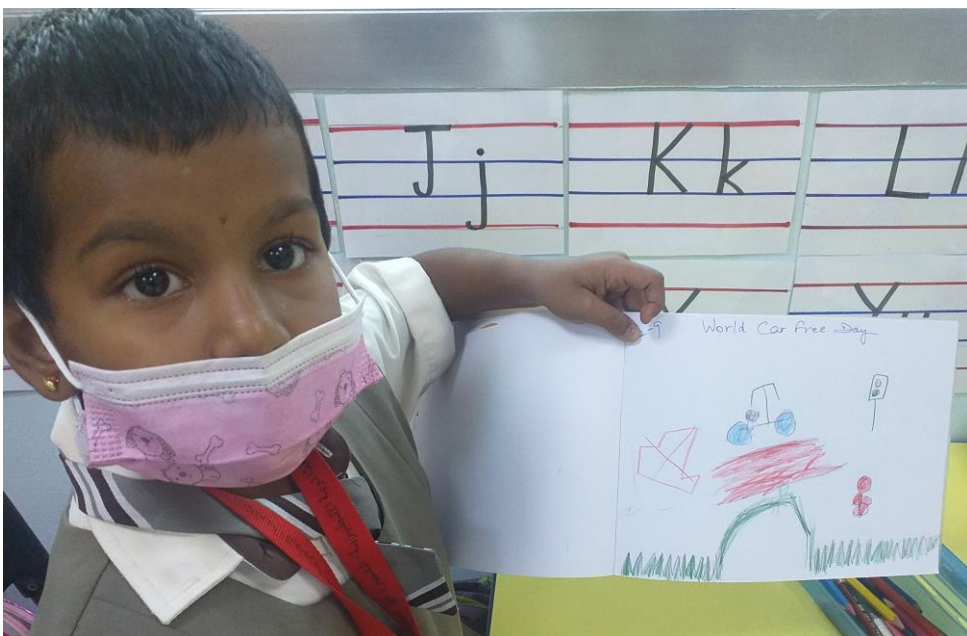
Why do we celebrate World Car free Day?
