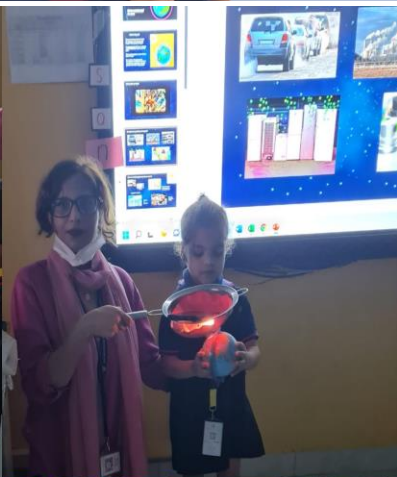
Ozone Day

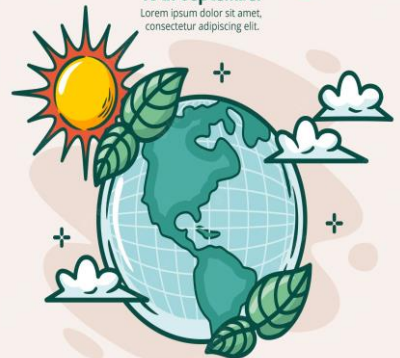

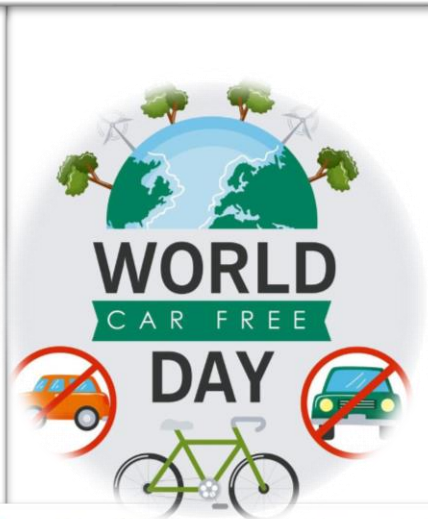


At EYFS , OOF students and teachers celebrated World free car day. Students were shared the benefits of using cars less.

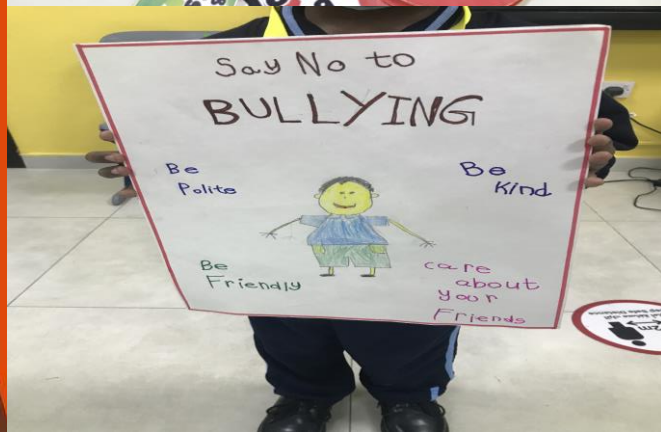
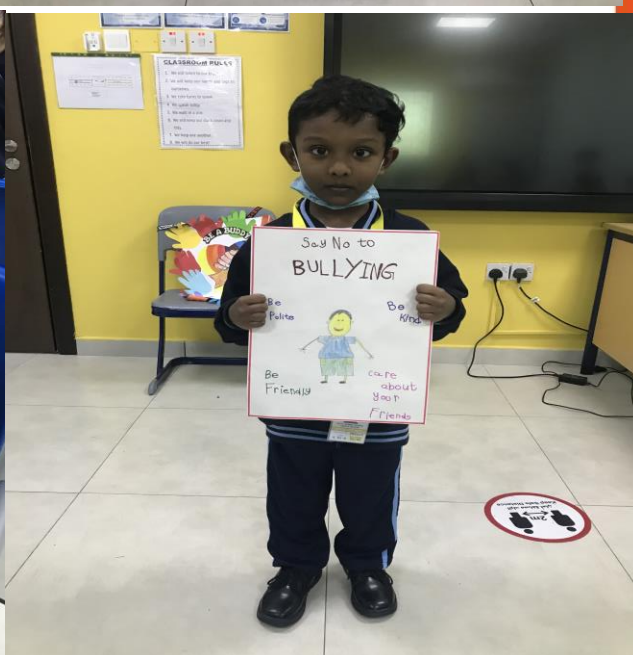
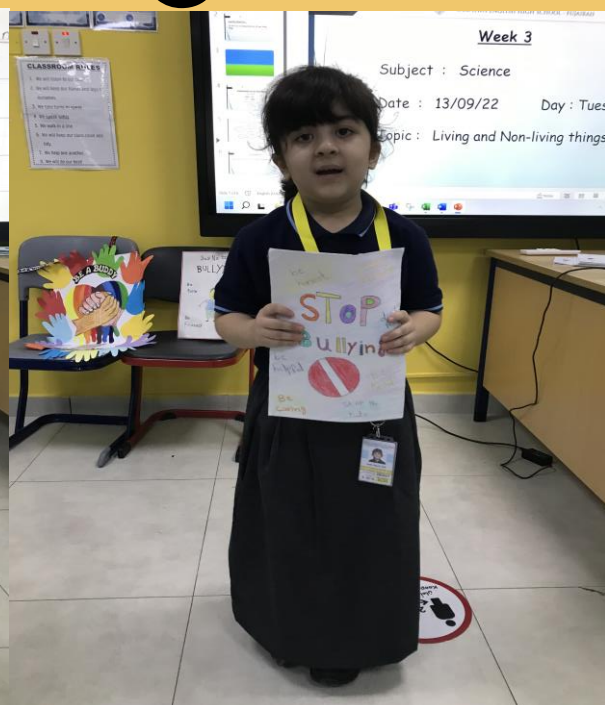
Why do we celebrate World Car free Day?

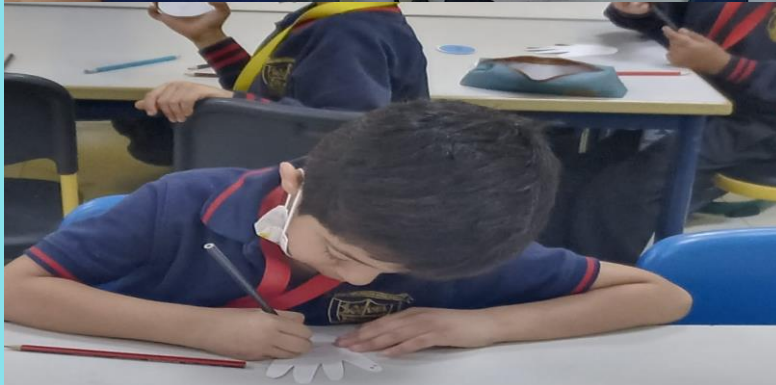
World Peace Day

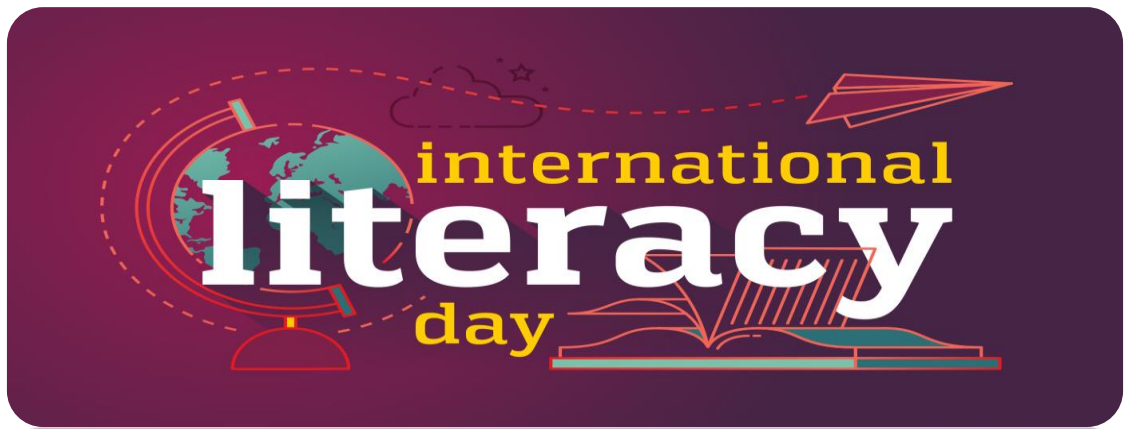


Literacy Day

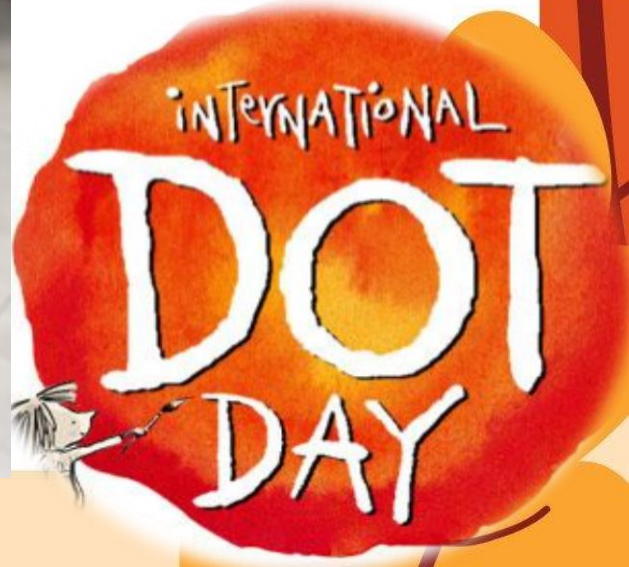

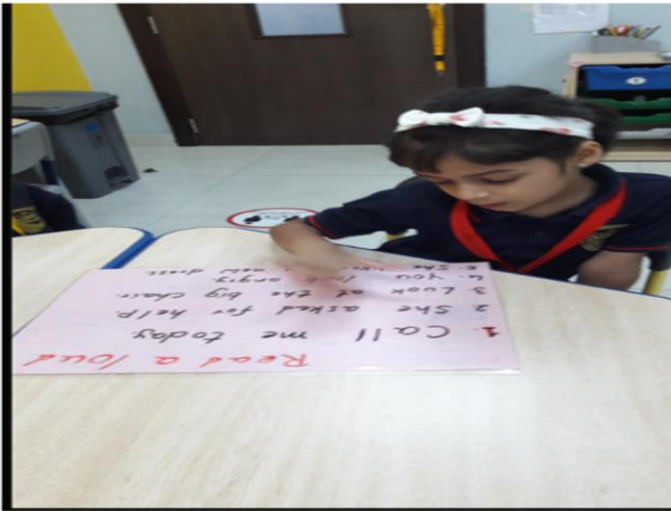

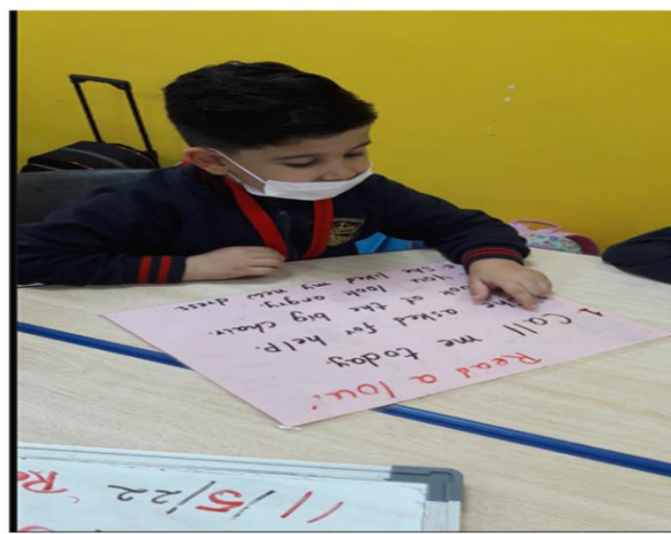

Reading books aloud to the students of Early Years stimulates their imagination and expands their understanding of the world. It helps them develop language and listening skills and prepares them to understand the written world.



Verbs IGCSE- EYFS

What is a verb? Verbs are words that show an action (sing), occurrence (develop), or state of being (exist). Almost every sentence requires a verb. The basic form of a verb is known as its infinitive.

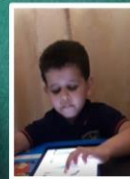
Many verbs give the idea of action, of "doing" something. For example, words like run, fight, do and work all convey action. But some verbs do not give the idea of action; they give the idea of existence, of state, of "being". For example, verbs like be, exist, seem and belong all convey state.
