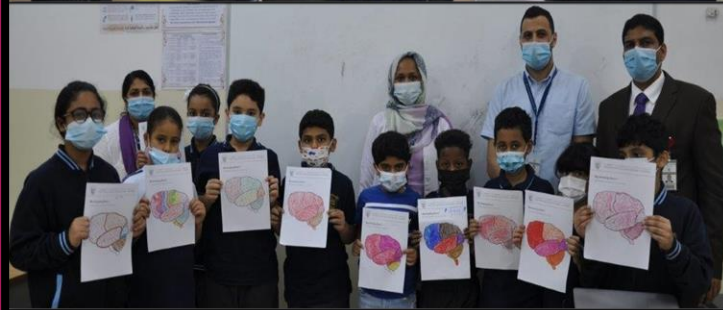
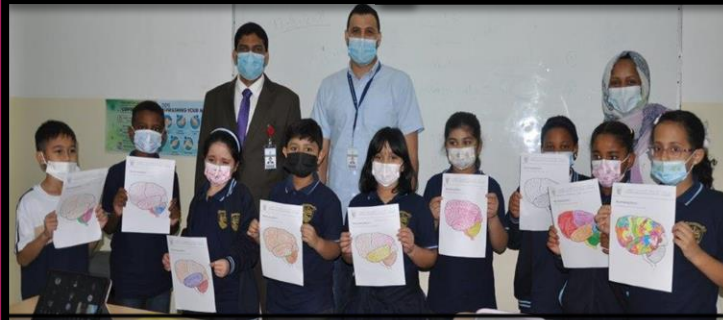
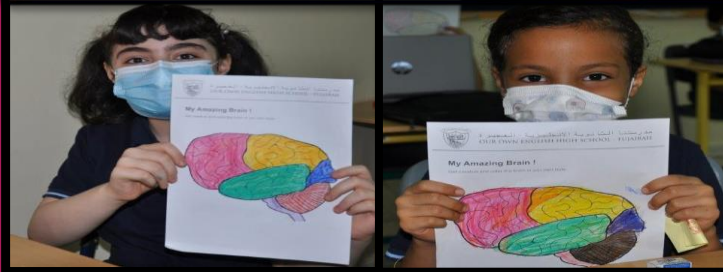
Alzheimer's Awareness Month

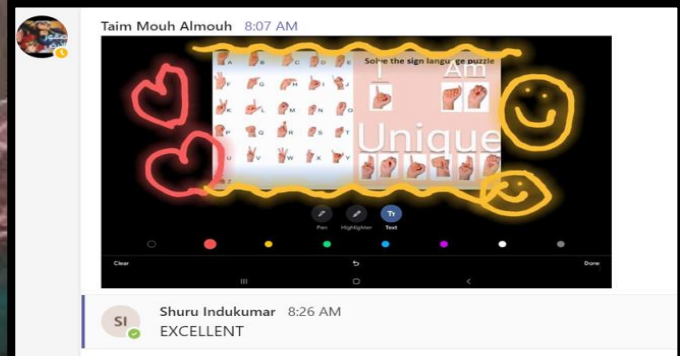
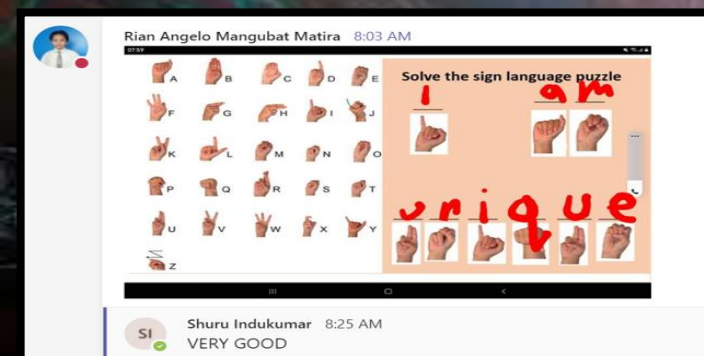

Math Story Telling Day

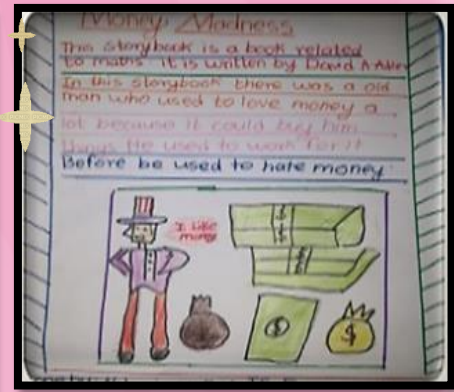
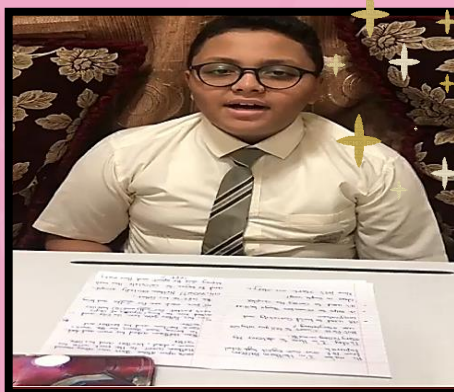
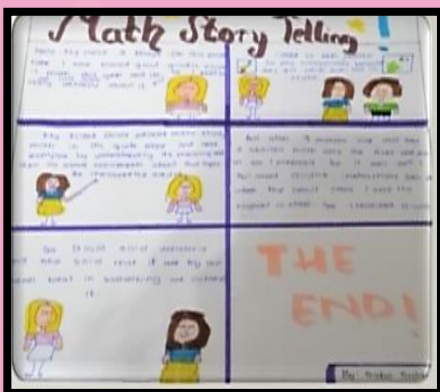
"Bringing play and a sense of narrative to problem solving"

United Nations Day

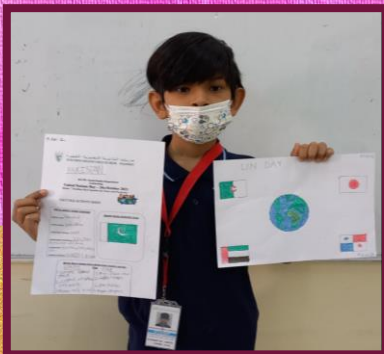
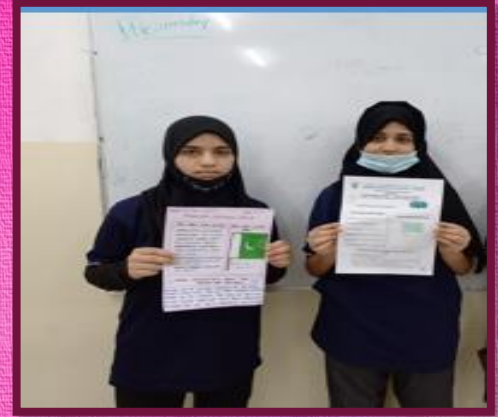


“There is no way to peace, peace is the way.”

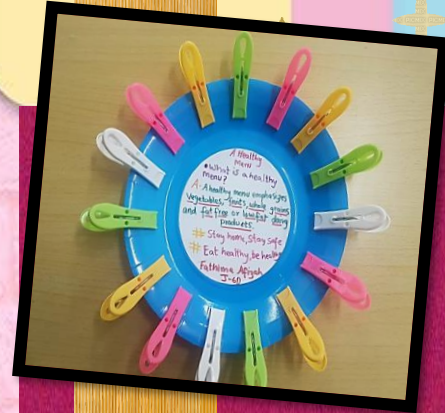

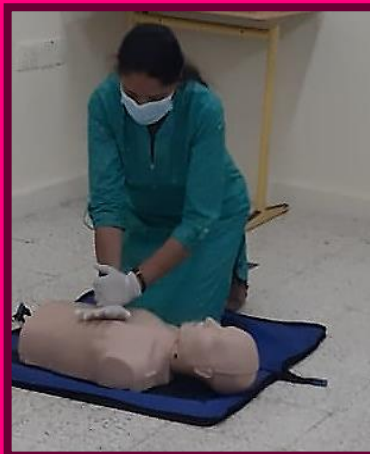
